Background

RRN3 (RRN3 Homolog, RNA Polymerase I Transcription Factor) is a Protein Coding gene. Among its related pathways are Gene Expression and Activated PKN1 stimulates transcription of AR (androgen receptor) regulated genes KLK2 and KLK3. GO annotations related to this gene include binding and RNA polymerase binding.

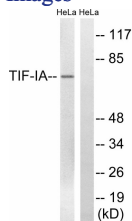
